

Green travel plan for Gateway, Leeds

BAM, Unit 2C, The Gateway East, Marsh Lane, Leeds, LS9 8AU



Introduction

BAM's North office is located in the Gateway East building, Marsh Lane, Leeds.

The office is a short walk from both the bus station and train station, and approximately 2 miles from the city centre.

Train

The Leeds train station for both national and local rail is 15 minutes' walk away.

Bus

The Leeds bus station is a 6 minutes' walk from the Gateway.

Car

Access method for Gateway coming in from M1/M621. As you are coming into Leeds you will need to go over the flyover coming off junction 4 of the M621. Follow A61 round into Leeds just before the city centre the road splits take the left split but get into the far-right hand lane. The access to site is on the right just after the set of traffic lights.

BAM has allocated car parking spaces. Please contact the office to book a space. Staff and visitors are encouraged to car share wherever possible.

Walking

The footways leading to and from the site are well maintained and well-lit with plenty of space for pedestrians.

Airports

Leeds Bradford airport is 9.4 miles away approximately 25 mins by car.

Cycle

There is existing provision of specific cycle lanes around the surrounding roads of the site. Cycles can be secured by owners on site in the underground car park.

Cycle storage is situated on the ground floor to the left of the ramp that goes to the upper floor.

Access code is C1567Z.

All bicycles are left at the owner's risk.
