

Green travel plan for Centrium, St Albans

Centrium, Griffiths Way, St Albans, Herts AL1 2RD



Introduction

Centrium Griffiths Way, is located just south of St Albans town centre.

Train

St Albans Abbey Station – The office is a 2 minute walk from this station which runs a service into Watford Junction, where you can connect to Euston mainline services.

St Albans City Station – The office is a short bus ride, or 30 minute walk, from this station which runs local service from Bedford in the north, through London to Brighton in the south. Both Gatwick and Luton Airports are served by this line.

Bus

The following bus routes run along St Stephen's Hill and/or Hollywell Hill: S4, S5, S8, S9, 321, 655, 724.

Cycle

Limited facilities are available for the storage of bicycles. Two showers are available.

Car

If travelling by road, follow the A414, take the exit into Watling Street and continue until you reach the next roundabout. Take the exit onto St Stephen's Hill. Continue along this road until the next roundabout onto Griffiths Way.

The office has limited parking spaces, so staff and visitors are encouraged to car share wherever possible.

Walk

The BAM Centrium office is only a 15 minute walk from St Albans town centre. The business park can be accessed via entrances on St Stephens Hill and Griffiths Way.

Tax

A taxi service is available via Gold Line taxis of St Albans on 01727 8333333.

Airports

London Luton Airport is 15 miles away (30 minutes by taxi) and London Heathrow is 26 miles away (40 minutes by taxi).
